There are 4 Mater Community CAMHS Teams. None of these teams are resourced to the levels recommended in *A Vision for Change*. The teams are especially underpowered in terms of medical staffing (*A Vision for Change* recommends one Consultant and one trainee per team / 50k population). Furthermore, the teams have NO psychiatric nurses.

Team A – North Inner City: Pop. 119K Consultant Psychiatrist 1.1 WTE; Trainee Psychiatrist 1 WTE

Team B – Ballymun: Pop. 37.5K Consultant Psychiatrist 0.45 WTE; Trainee Psychiatrist 1 WTE

Team C/D – Coolock/Darndale: Pop. 101K Consultant Psychiatrist 1.3 WTE; Trainee Psychiatrist 1.5 WTE

Team E – Swords and Nth County Dublin: Pop. 123K Consultant Psychiatrist 1.6 WTE; Trainee Psychiatrist 1.5 WTE

An interim 6 bedded adolescent unit for 16-17 year olds opened in St Vincent's Hospital, Fairview on March 9 <sup>th</sup> 2009. A further 6 beds are planned for 2011.
There is a 6 bedded inpatient unit for 0-16 year old children at Warrenstown House which serves all of Dublin city. There are plans to open an additional 4 beds in 2011.
There are twenty acute inpatient beds planned for the National Paediatric Hospital (2014) of which 6-8 will be for complex eating disorders.
